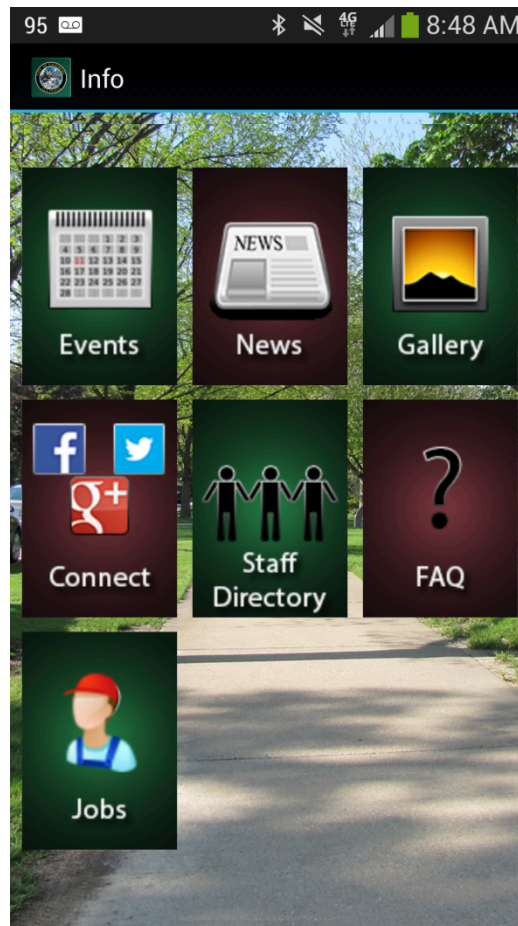

- Free Wi-Fi – Highlights the areas that free Wi-Fi can be accessed
- Galesburg Transit – Highlights all of the Galesburg Transit bus routes and stops
- Food – Pinpoints restaurants
- Parks – Highlights all of the public parks
- Parking – Highlights the areas of downtown where parking is free
- Shopping – Pinpoints shops




File Report Screen
